CODE OF ETHICS

We as members of the Summit County Builders Association believe and affirm that:

- (A) Home ownership can and should be within reach of every American.
- (B) American Homes should be well-designed, well-constructed and well-located in attractive communities with education, recreational, religious and shopping facilities accessible to all.
- (C) American homes should be built under the free American enterprise system.
- (D) To achieve these goals, we pledge allegiance to the following principles and policies:
